- Form of autocracy gained by birth
- System where the government has total control over everything
- Type of monarchy in which the King/Queen is ceremonial and the Parliament runs the government
- Type of monarchy where King/Queen runs the government with complete control
- Political philosopher who described the state of nature as "nasty, brutish, and short."
- Governing system with the national government in charge
- The Great Charter which limited the power of the King of England
- Rule by a few

- Governing system with the state governments in charge
- Institution thru which the state maintains order, provides services, and enforces binding decisions
- Theory that people agree to surrender some freedoms in exchange for government protection and order
- Form of autocracy gained by fear or force
- One person holds unlimited political power
- The final authority of a government within its territorial boundaries
- A government controlling the economic, political, and social lives of the citizens
- System with no government or form of authority
